Dear General Cutler:

I thought the President and you would be interested in the following information regarding the Nationalist Party of Puerto Rico which is related to the information contained in the enclosure to my letter of December 11, 1953.

A source of unknown reliability furnished the following information regarding the plans of Jose Antonio Negrón Rodriguez, a member of the Nationalist Party of Puerto Rico who is presently incarcerated at the Insular Penitentiary, Rio Piedras, Puerto Rico.

Negrón continues to believe that he will be released from prison sometime in December, 1953. In addition to planning to steal weapons from the National Guard Armory at Bayamon, Puerto Rico, Negrón is now considering the possibility of stealing weapons from the National Guard Armory at Aibonito, Puerto Rico.

The source advised that prior to Juan Jose Muñoz Matos' release from prison on December 11, 1953, Negrón gave Muñoz Matos the complete plans for the robbery of the armory at Bayamon, Puerto Rico. It is reported that Muñoz Matos will not do anything concerning

the robbery of this armory until it is known whether or not other incarcerated Nationalists will be released from prison in the immediate future.

Negron allegedly discussed the wiring of Federal Bureau of Investigation automobiles with bombs.

Negron also plans to destroy United States communication centers in Puerto Rico.

It is also reported that a representative from the office of the Governor of Puerto Rico allegedly visited Negron and requested him to sign a statement denouncing the Nationalist Party of Puerto Rico in exchange for his freedom.
