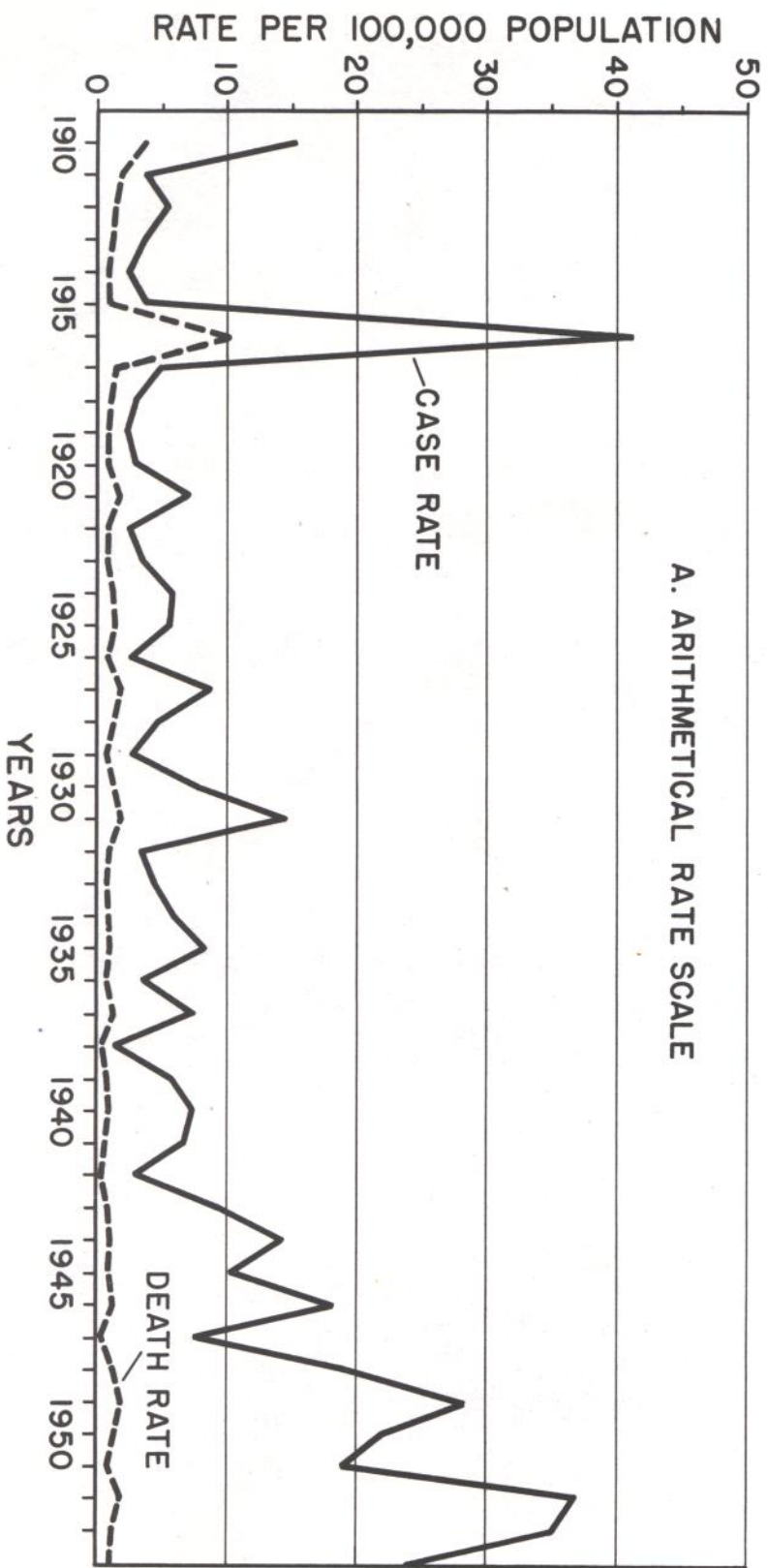
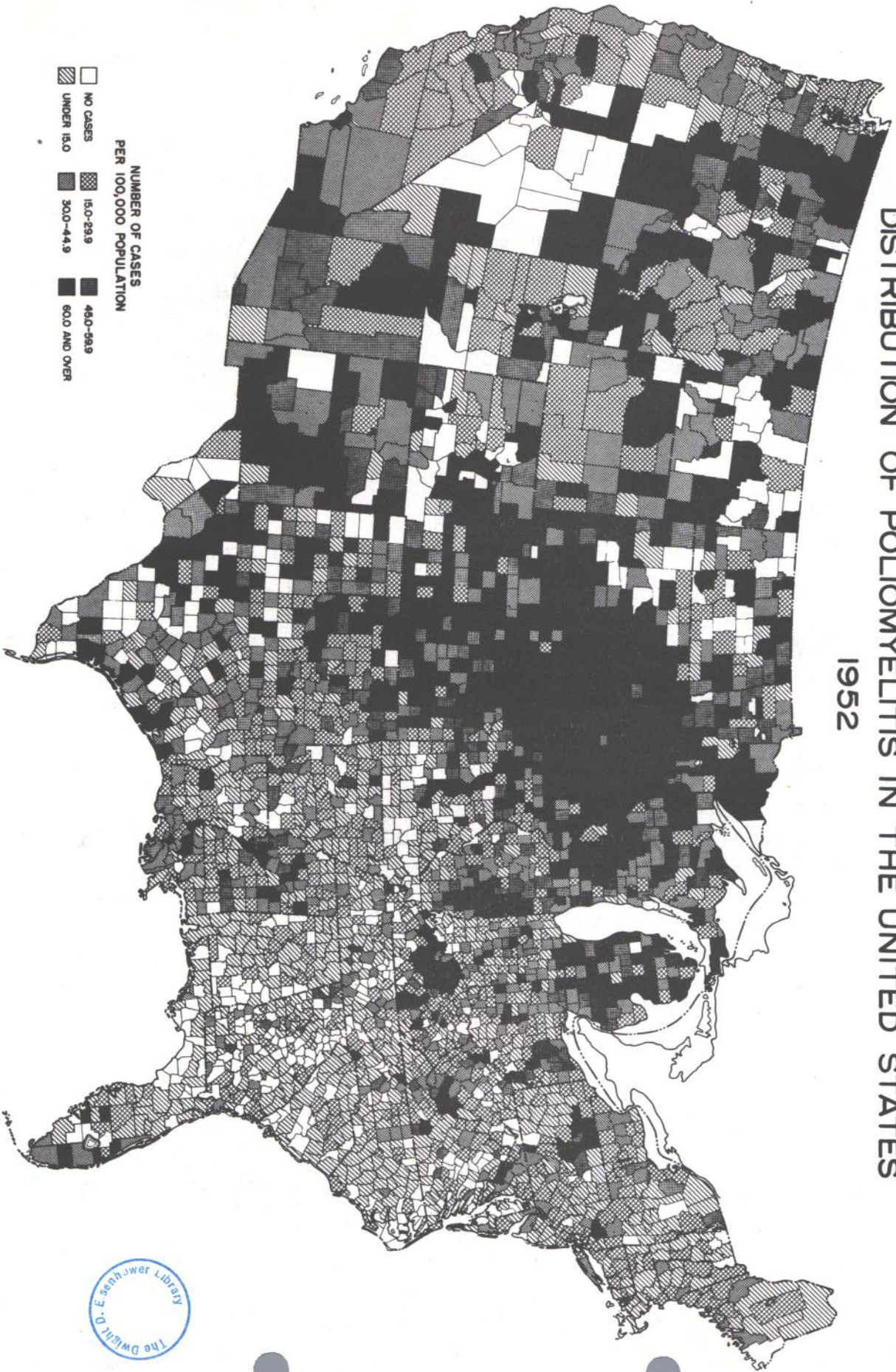

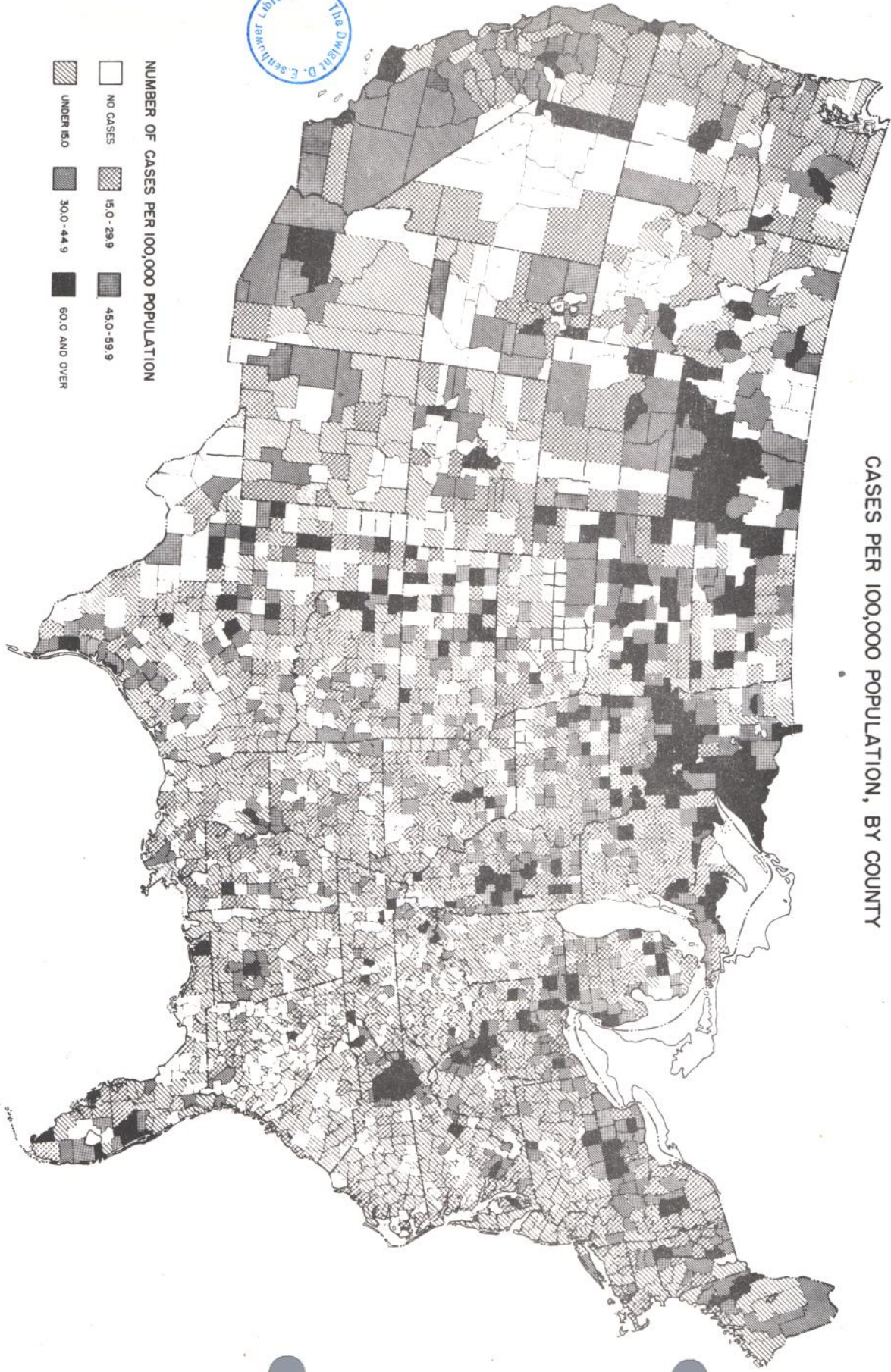
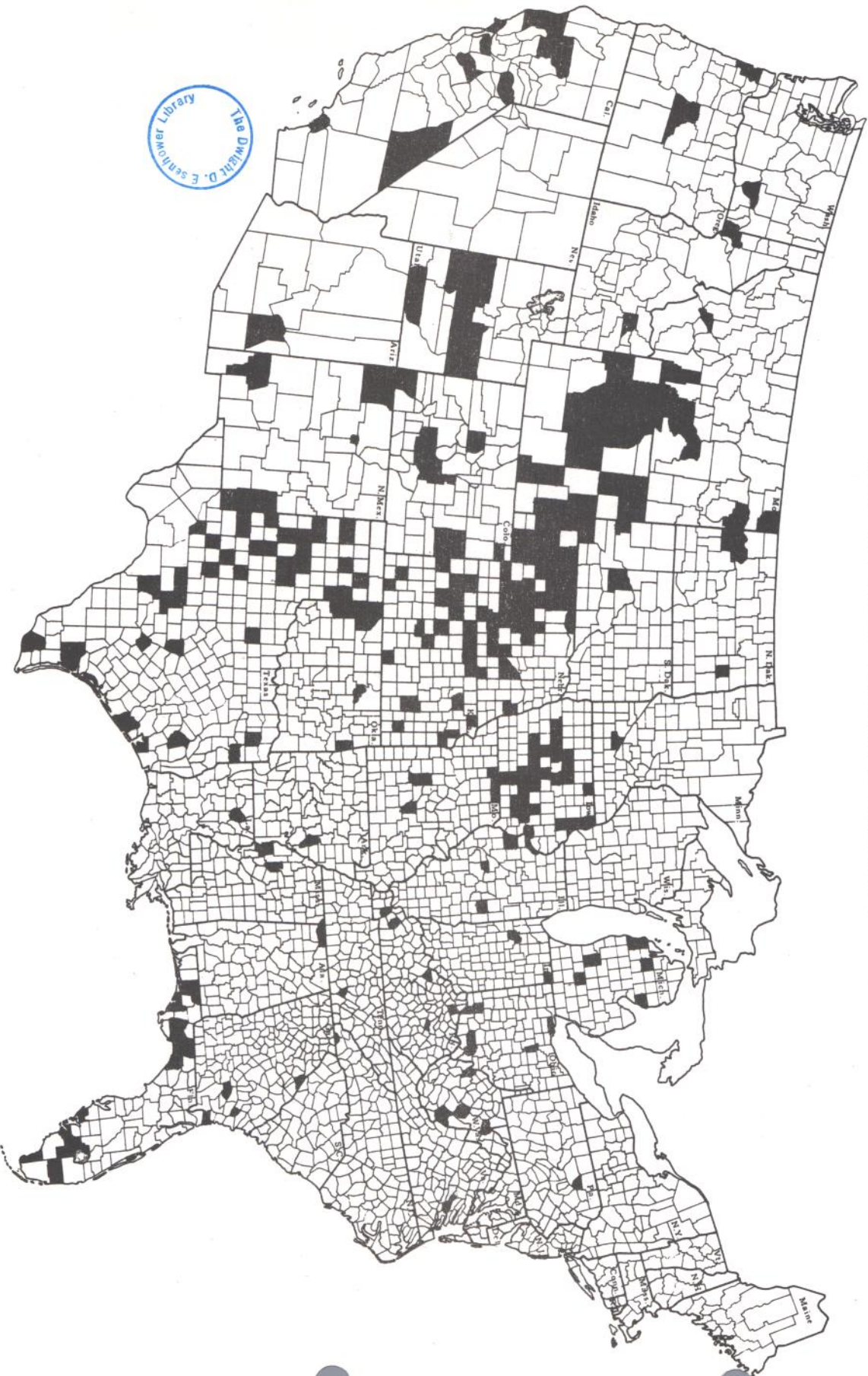
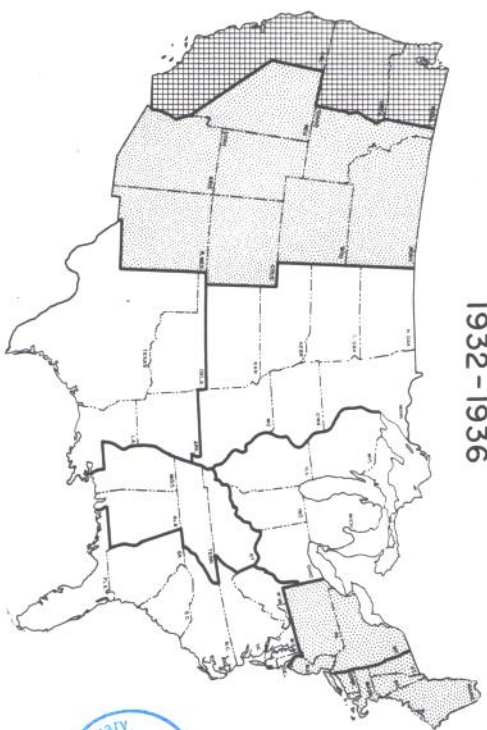

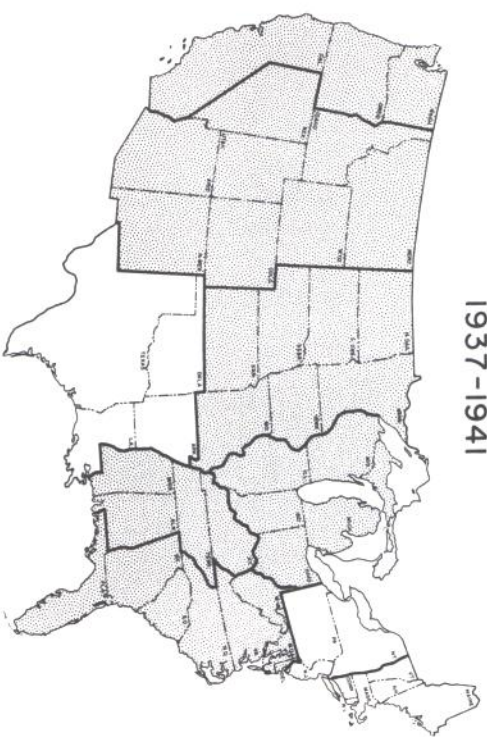
POLIOMYELITIS IN THE UNITED STATES, 1954

(Based on preliminary figures)



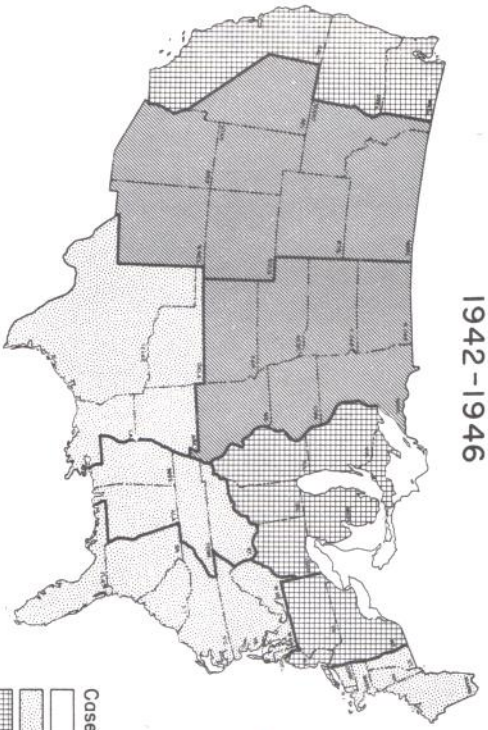
POLIOMYELITIS MORBIDITY - AVERAGE FIVE YEAR RATES
 MAJOR GEOGRAPHIC DIVISIONS OF THE UNITED STATES



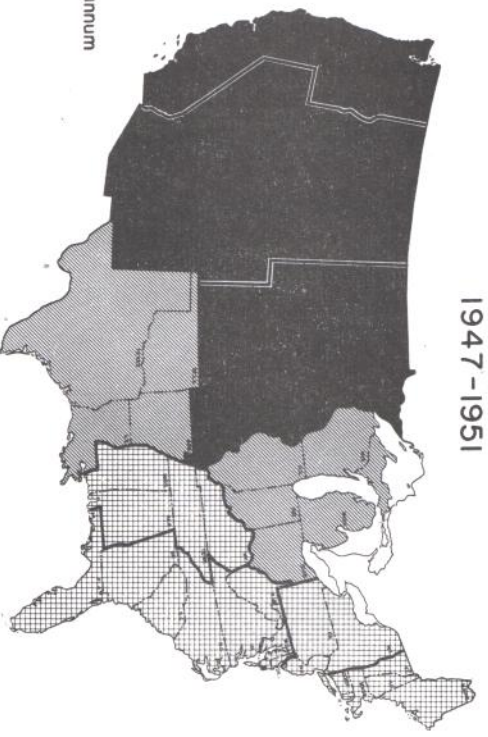

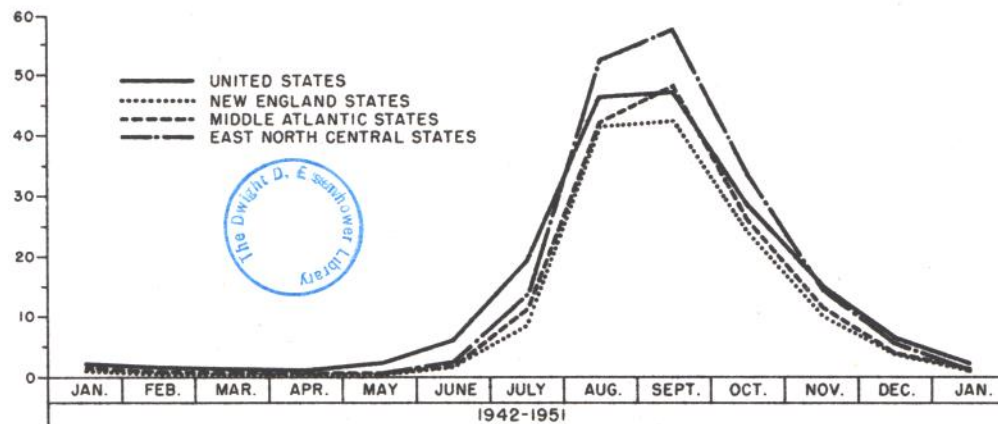
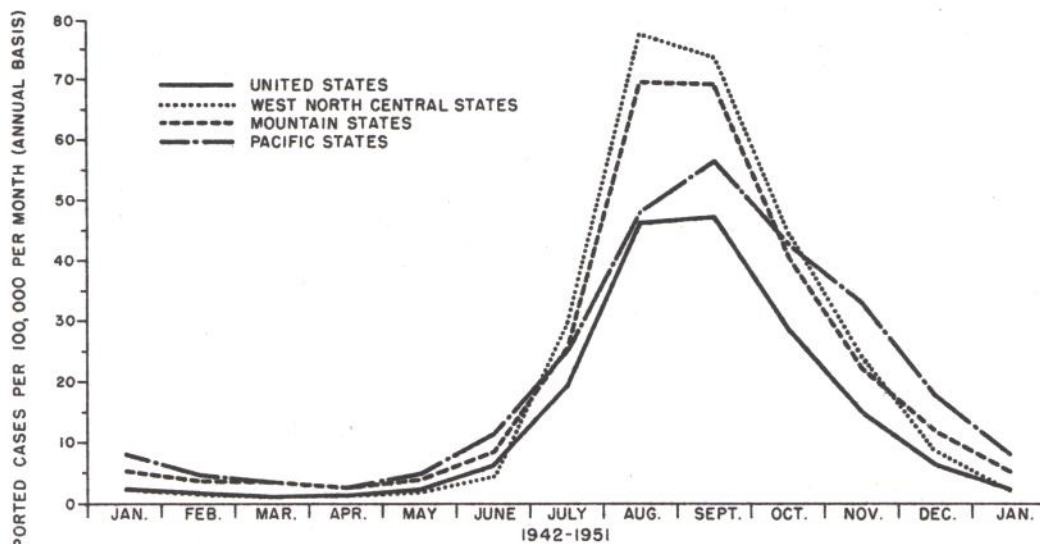
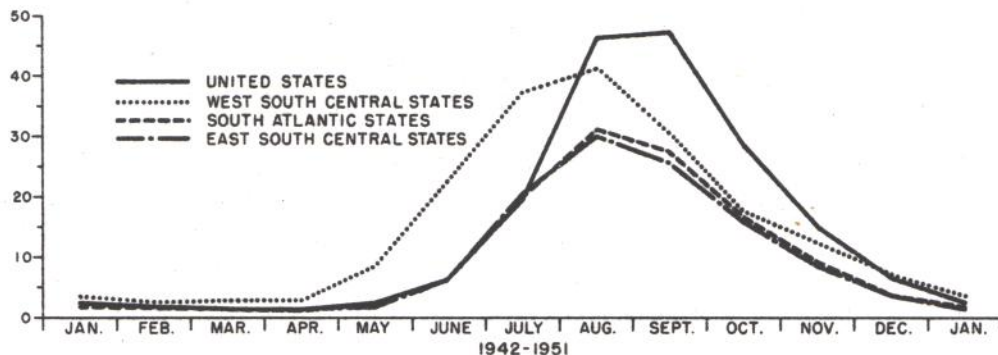

POLIOMYELITIS - CASES REPORTED FROM SELECTED STATES BY AGE - 1952

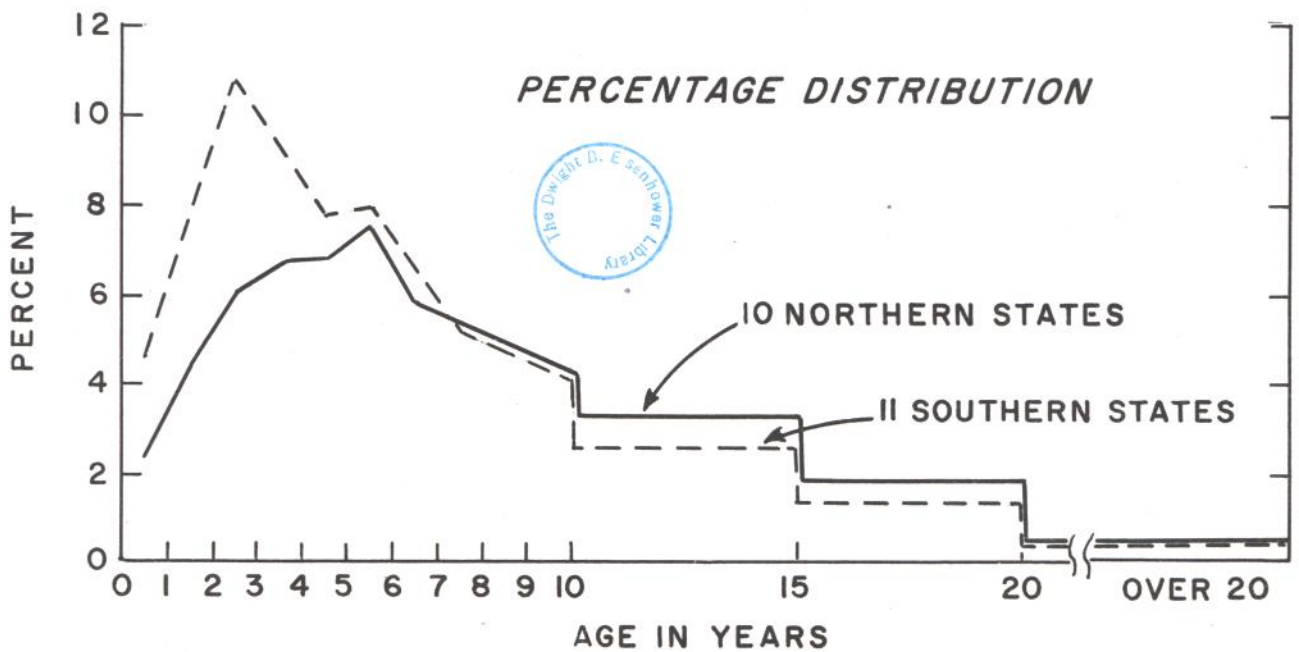
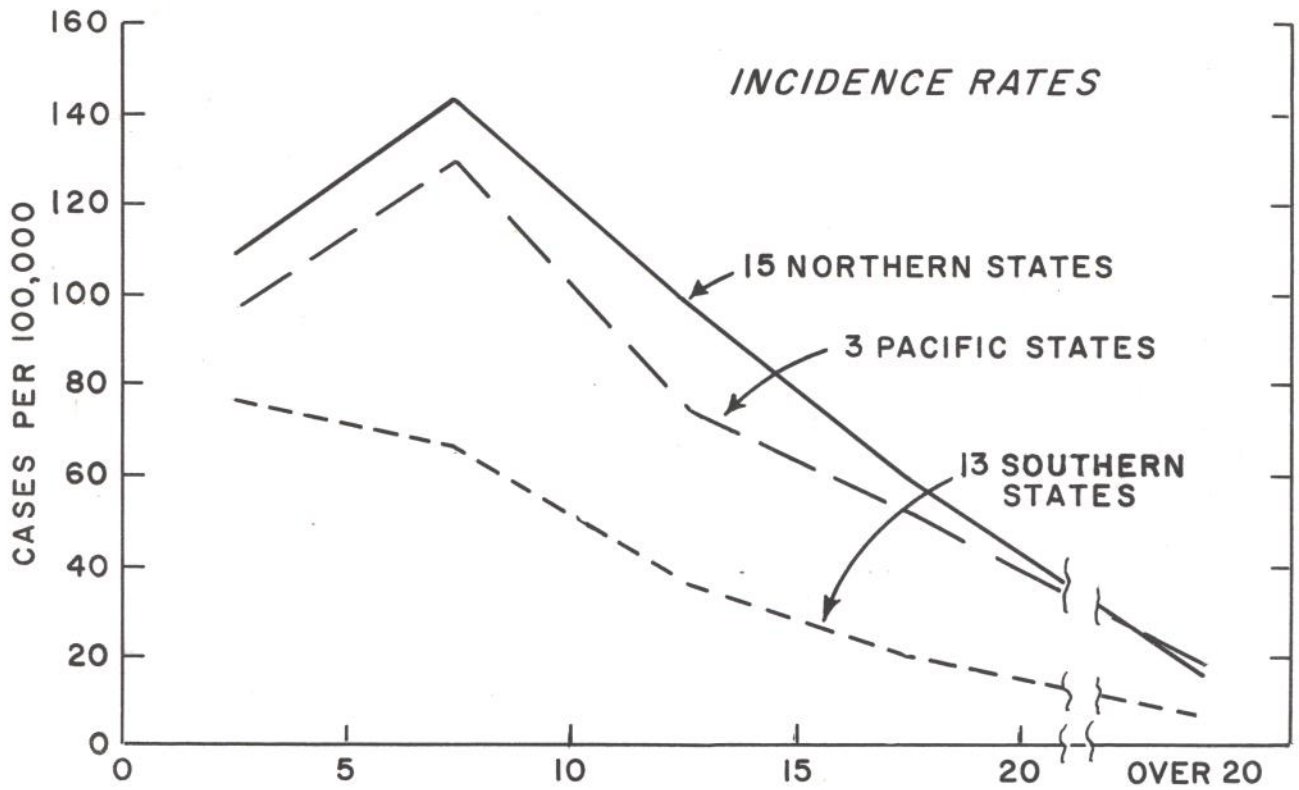
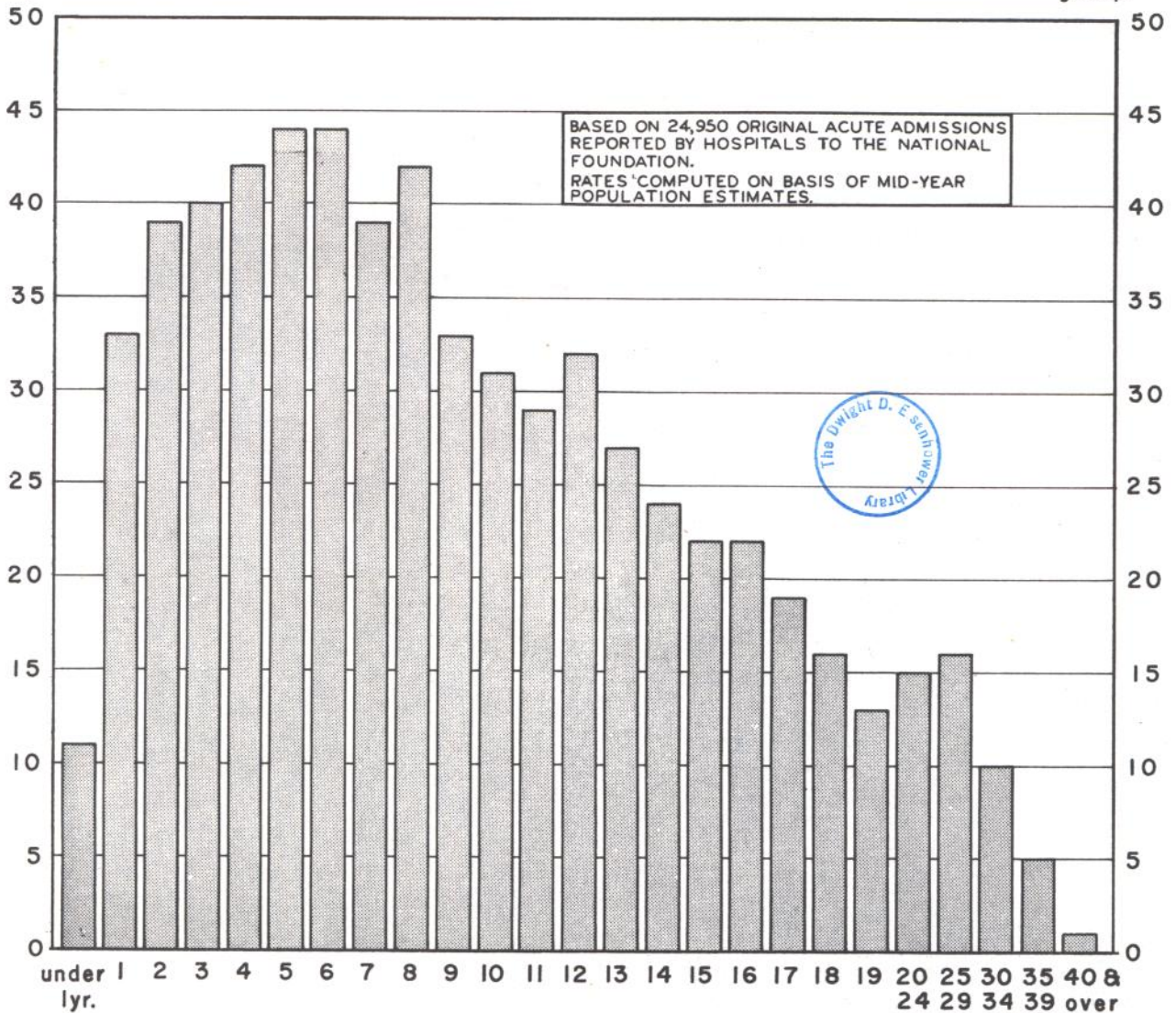
